"The whole thing was such an amazing experience," says Cindy. "Everyone here seems to get an opportunity like this at some point, and I'm so grateful to work at a salon that makes these kinds of experiences possible."

"If you were to take the more structured styles of the '40s and loosen them up, that's the look right now," he explains. "Hair is romantic and long with very soft edges."

Even for naturally curly hair, curling irons are a popular option for creating super-lush looks. Anthony recommends a ceramic curling iron for best results and less stress on hair. Ponytails are hot this summer, as are hair accessories such as silk flowers worn at the top of the ponytail.

The feminine, romantic looks seen in clothing and hair fashion are echoed in today's freshest makeup looks. Green and khaki eyes are popular, as are faces featuring metallic tones or lavender and rose shades.

A terrific hair cut and color - such as blended tone-on-tone copper or golden shades - are essential to achieving this season's styles. But so are styling and conditioning products designed to maximize and control natural curl or promote more curls when styling.

"You want to use those products to make the hair look really finished," says Anthony. "And treatment products are really important if your hair is colored or you spend a lot of time in the sun or chlorine. They'll keep your hair in good condition so it holds styling and color better."
